Beginning Wood Turning

Students will get hands-on experience using the basic lathe tools. The primary focus is technique - learning the basics of spindle turning, bowl turning, tool selection and tool sharpening. Each student will then practice these skills on a lathe.

Pen Turning

Students will learn how to cut pen blanks, drill and mount the blanks on a lathe, turn the pen barrels and apply the finish. The final step will be assembling the pen. Each student will complete a pen during the class.

Bowl Turning

This course is designed for the beginning or intermediate turner who wants to get a better handle on bowl turning. Topics covered will include wood selection, preparation, mounting options, tool selection, sharpening, power sanding and finishing. Each student will complete a bowl during the class.

Students will learn how to cut blanks to maximize the Natural edge. Topics will include mounting, tool selection and use, how to save the bark and finishing. Each student will then mount and turn a NE Bowl.
